**SUBJECT: NUTRITION POLICY**

The Superintendent, working in conjunction with the administrative staff, will develop procedures to ensure that students have access to healthy meals in all education settings, including at home instruction and in-person instruction. Procedures must include, but not be limited to, the provision for meal service in all settings which adhere to policies and procedures regarding health and safety; the following of all applicable state, local, and national policies; the provision of school meals each day to any student “enrolled in the SFA” who attends school either in-person or remotely; promotion of appropriate hand hygiene before and after meals and the discouragement of sharing food and beverages; protection of students with food allergies in all settings; the cleaning and disinfection of eating spaces between groups of dining students; compliance with the Child Nutrition Program; and communication with student’s families regarding food service in their native language. Procedures must provide for the provision of appropriate cleaning and disinfectant supplies to food service staff as well as personal protective equipment.

This policy will supersede and modify any existing policies regarding nutrition/meal service and the custodial services relevant thereto. This policy will remain in effect for the duration of the state of emergency declared by the Governor of the State of New York as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.
