SUBJECT: PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT POLICY

The Superintendent, working in conjunction with the administrative staff, will develop procedures for the provision and application of personal protective equipment (PPE) on District property. Procedures will dictate that PPE must be worn when required by the nature of an activity, and PPE must be appropriately selected for an activity. Procedures will provide for the acquisition of an appropriate amount of PPE for District staff and students, and call for staff and students to be provided PPE at no cost when appropriate. Procedures will specifically mandate that face coverings of an appropriate type be worn at any time policy and procedure regarding social distancing cannot be followed. Procedures will mandate that New York State Executive Order No. 202.16 is followed at all times. Procedures will mandate that children younger than 2 years old, individuals who have trouble breathing, or anyone who becomes incapacitated or unconscious must not be required to wear a face mask.

This policy will supersede and modify any existing policies regarding personal protective equipment. This policy will remain in effect for the duration of the state of emergency declared by the Governor of the State of New York as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.
