Operations**SUBJECT: TRANSPORTATION POLICY**

The Superintendent, working in conjunction with the administrative staff, will develop procedures which require students to follow personal protective equipment (PPE) policies while utilizing District provided transportation services, including but not limited to, policies regarding the wearing of face masks at all appropriate times. Procedures will require students and staff using District provided transportation services to follow social distancing procedures and policies at all times possible. Procedures must mandate that all transportation vehicles be cleaned and disinfected at least once a day, with high contact areas being cleaned and disinfected after each morning, afternoon, or other transportation run. Procedures will dictate that transportation services be configured to allow for handicap students to maintain social distancing during their ride. Procedures must require that transportation staff wear face coverings and appropriate PPE at all times if such staff makes regular contact with students, and perform self-health screenings while following procedures and policies relevant thereto before coming to work. Procedures must provide for the transportation of students when necessary even when this District is utilizing remote learning.

This policy will supersede and modify any existing policies regarding transportation. This policy will remain in effect for the duration of the state of emergency declared by the Governor of the State of New York as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.
