**SUBJECT: SECONDARY STUDENTS GRADING**

The Board of Education is committed to providing opportunities for all students to succeed. In the secondary schools, quarterly report card grades shall not be lower than fifty (50). If the actual quarterly grade is, in fact, a number lower than fifty (50), the teacher will note "actual grade lower than fifty" in the comment portion of the report card.

All mid-term, final exam, and Regents exam grades will be posted as earned regardless of a score below fifty (50).

This policy is intended to provide students with the opportunity to recover from a quarter of poor performance rather than reduce effort or drop a course because there is no mathematical possibility of success.
