**SUBJECT: STUDENT PUBLICATIONS**

The Board of Education recognizes the value of official school publications in teaching journalism, English, writing and other skills. An official school publication is defined as materials produced by students in the journalism, newspaper, yearbook, or writing classes and distributed to the student body either free or for a fee. All student publications shall be served by at least one adult advisor employed by the District.

The District may exercise editorial control over the style and content of student speech in school sponsored publications and activities that are part of the educational curriculum.
