SUBJECT: STUDENT PERFORMANCES

The Board of Education recognizes the importance of student performances in the development of creative expression and the "celebration of aesthetic and personal achievement". The Board of Education recognizes the importance of student performances in generating community knowledge and support. Public performances for other than educational merit must be authorized by the Board of Education.

Student performance will focus on the following purposes:

- a) School centered programs.
- b) Community functions for school's educational needs.
- c) School exhibitions held as part of curriculum on a non-profit basis.
- d) Educational broadcasts including music festivals and competitions sponsored by schools.
- e) Civic functions of local, state or national interests with sufficient breadth to enlist the general support and cooperation of the community.
- f) Local charity benefits where the intent is not to substitute for professional musicians.
- g) Other services that might be mutually agreed upon by school authorities and official representatives of local professional musicians.
