SUBJECT: CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION POLICY

The Superintendent, working in conjunction with the administrative staff, will develop procedures relevant to Career and Technical Education (CTE) classes and students that identifies content which takes precedence in the event instructional capabilities change throughout the school year, identifies activities that can be completed by students independently, provide students access to necessary learning materials, utilize online platforms when possible, and provide for proper hygiene, cleaning, and sanitization in classroom settings. Procedures must allow for coordination with businesses and industries who take part in CTE education to ensure safe and healthy learning opportunities.

This policy will supersede and modify any existing policies regarding CTE services. This policy will remain in effect for the duration of the state of emergency declared by the Governor of the State of New York as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.
