**SUBJECT: SUMMER SCHOOL**

The Board of Education will sponsor, when economically feasible, a summer school program providing opportunities for remedial and enrichment instruction at the elementary level and course work for promotion/credit standards at the secondary level.

The summer school curriculum will be established in line with the needs of students and in accordance with any local and/or state regulations.

Students who are residents of the Elmira City School District will not be required to pay a registration fee for participation in the Elmira City School District's Summer School Program.

Students who are not residents of the Elmira City School District shall be required:

- a) To pay a fee equivalent to \$30 per course for participation in the Elmira City School District's Elementary Summer School Program.
- b) To pay a fee equivalent to \$125 per course to participate in the District's Secondary Summer School Program.
- c) To be registered for the Driver Education Course only on a space available basis after all residents of the Elmira City School District who register for the course are placed. The payment of a \$250 registration fee shall be required.
- d) To pay a deposit of \$5.00/textbook for the use of District textbooks. This deposit will be refundable with the return of the textbooks in substantially the same condition as when borrowed.

Fees will be refundable as per the following schedule:

1. Through the conclusion of the first day of classes – 100%
2. Through the conclusion of the second day of classes – 50%
3. After the second day of class – 0%

**Admission Standards**

- a) A student requesting to take summer course for make-up purposes must have:
  1. Maintained a minimum class average of 50 in a requested full-credit course, and
  2. Missed no more than 30 class sessions.

- b) The home school principal may request the waiving of grade and attendance requirements for extenuating circumstances.

**NOTE:** Non-District registration fees shall increase annually at a rate equivalent to the Regional CPI for the previous year ending December 31.

**Definition:** Non-Resident Student - an individual younger than twenty-years of age who does not reside within the boundaries of the Elmira City School District on June 1 of the current year and who has not earned a high school diploma.
